

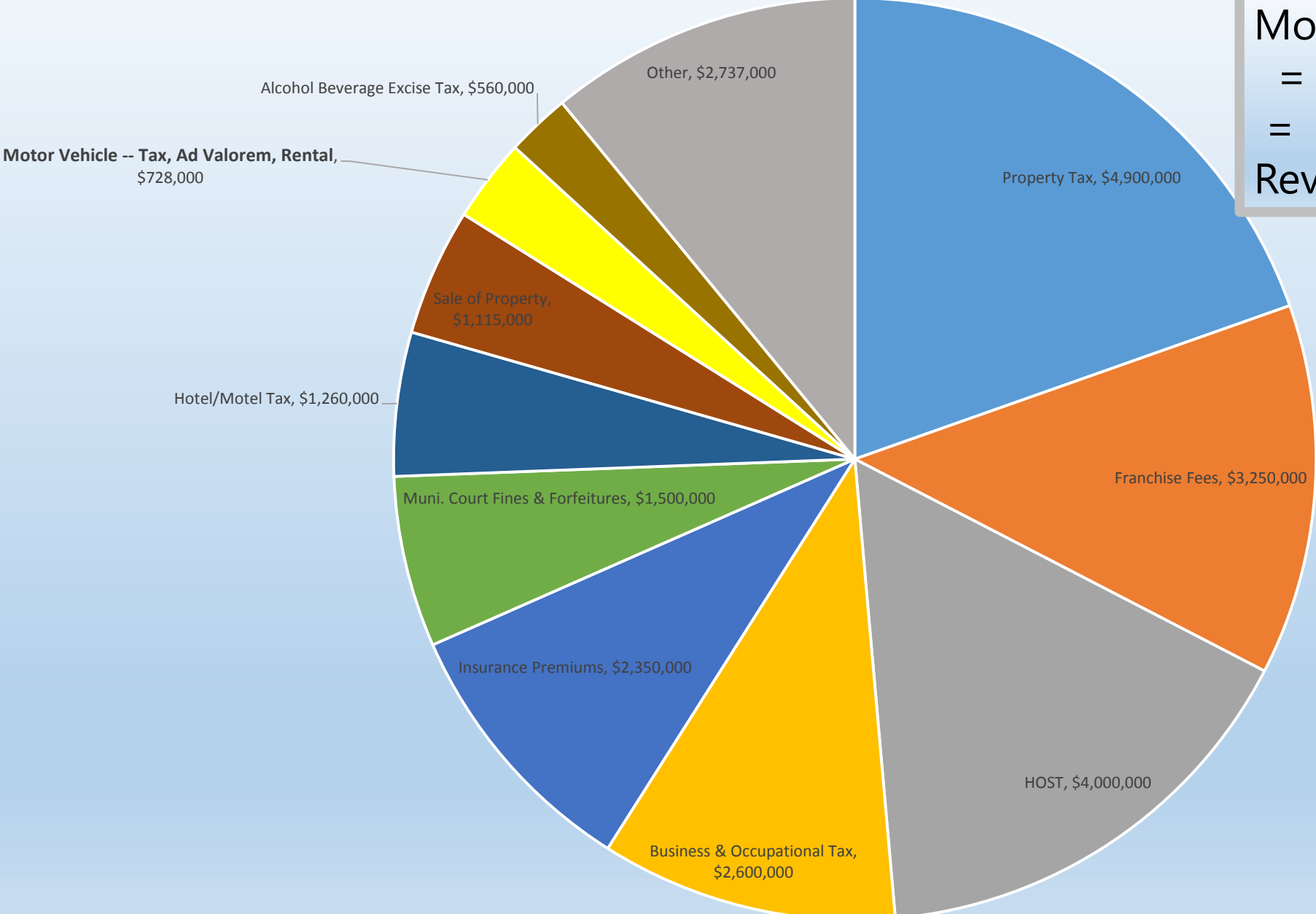

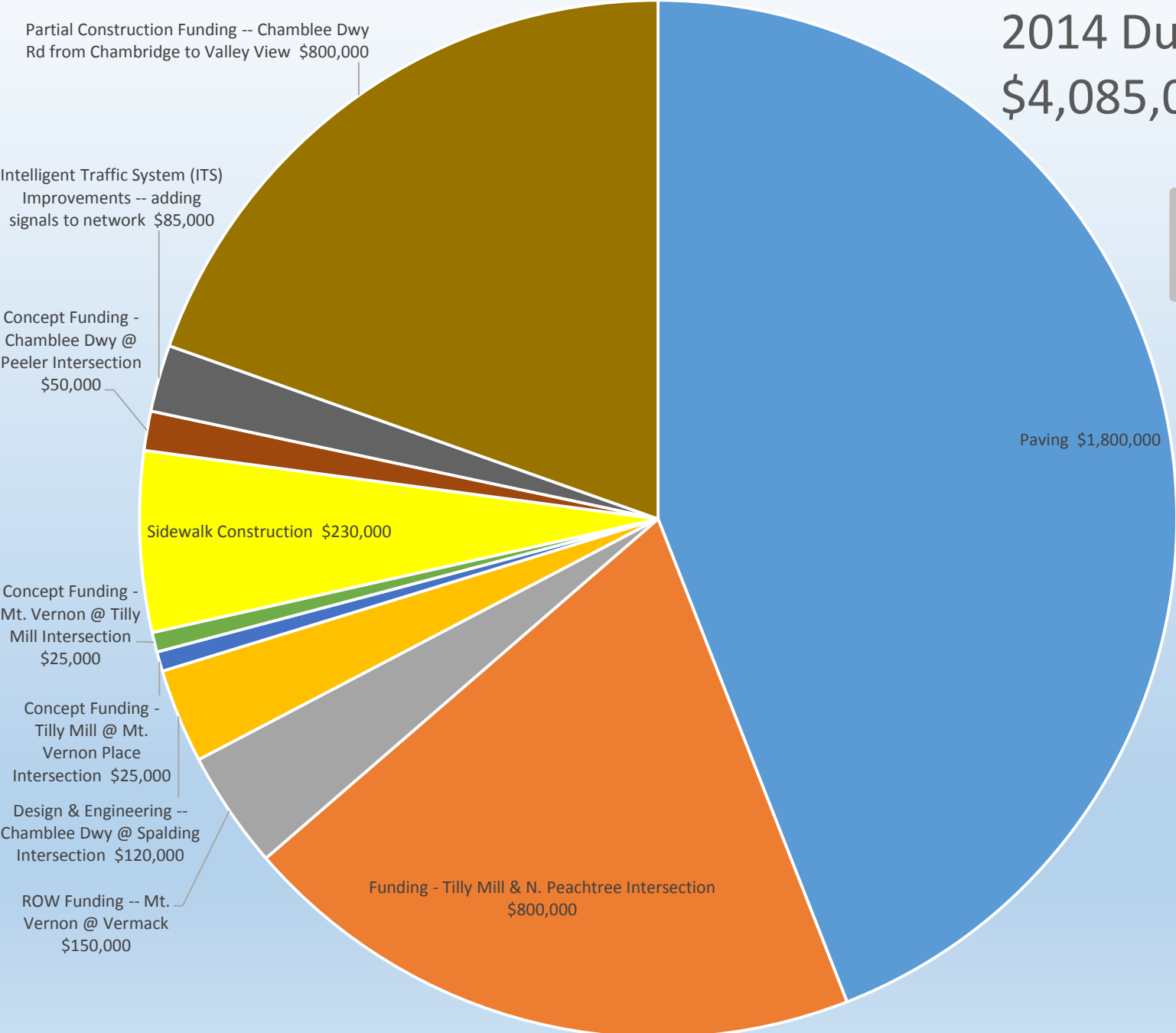
2014 Dunwoody Top Ten Sources of Revenue



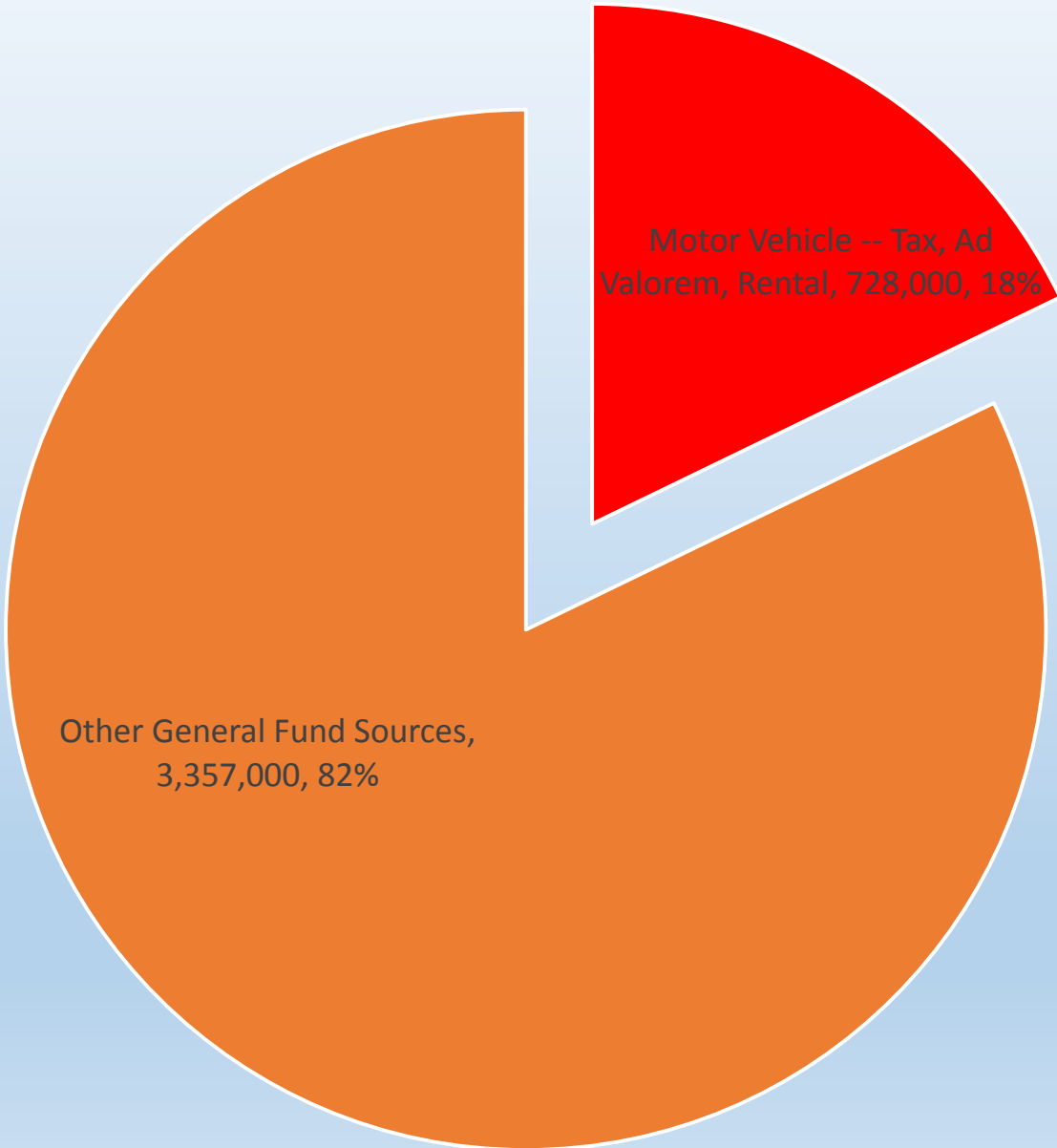
Motor Vehicle Taxes & Fees
= \$728k
= 3 Percent of Total
Revenue

2014 Dunwoody Public Works Projects: \$4,085,000

Total General Fund Budget = \$25M
Public Works = 16 Percent of General Funds



2014 Dunwoody Motor Vehicle Taxes & Fees as a Percentage of Funding for Transportation



Motor Vehicle Revenues represent

18 Percent

of the **total funds** spent on
transportation projects
